

UPVC MULTI-POINT LOCK ID SHEET

Complete this form to help us identify and source your replacement door lock.



1. Key Measurements (The "Vital" Dimensions)

Please measure in Millimetres (mm). Measurements are taken from the centre of the spindle/keyhole.

PZ Centres (A):		Distance from center of handle spindle to center of key circle. (Common: 92mm, 70mm, 62mm)
Backset (B):		Distance from the front of the faceplate to the center of the spindle. (Common: 35mm, 45mm)
Faceplate Width:		Width of the metal strip that runs down the edge of the door. (Common: 16mm, 20mm)
Overall Length:		Total length of the metal faceplate strip.

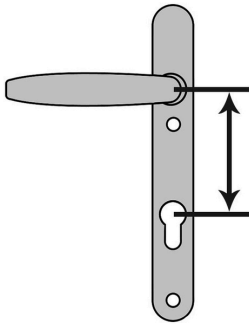

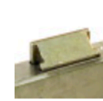
